

SPECIFICATION & PROCEDURAL DATA SHEET

ORGANOIL - GARDEN FURNITURE OIL

CLASSIC CLEAR - RED Hardwood Enhancer

- DESCRIPTION:** A low sheen finishing oil that penetrates the timber substrate to nourish, preserve and seal; as well as providing protection against weather degradation and rot.
- INGREDIENTS:** Filtered, unmodified Tung Nut Oil, Citrus, Eucalypt and Pine Wood oils/extracts with dissolved, refined Bees Wax. UV rated colourant in the form of Dye added to the Red & Gold Enhancers
- USES:** **Exterior** - Preserving and finishing timber garden furniture, spa panelling, shutters, louvres, gunstocks, marine trims & handrails **Clear** best suited to furniture & joinery under full verandah protection, **Red Hardwood** will give more longevity to fully exposed timbers.
Internal – Timber bench tops and vanities in wet areas i.e. bathrooms & laundries. The ingredients in this product best address their needs, **though not to be used on flooring**.
Note: The wet sanding procedure should be followed if seeking a patina/sheen on bench tops, gunstocks, marine trims & handrails (refer, www.prep-productions.com "How to Video")
- SPECIAL NOTES:**
- To test timber for oil application suitability – sprinkle water onto timber, if water beads or sits on top **do not use oil**; if water is absorbed into the timber it is suitable for oil application following can instructions.
 - With new garden furniture settings—many are supplied pre-treated with solutions containing biocides (volatile chemicals insecticide/fungicides) which can react with Tung Oil causing surface whitening. If this occurs, and to rectify, apply more oil and agitate affected areas with a green synthetic scourer (Scotchbrite) then rub over with clean cloth.
 - Previously finished settings which have remains of the prior finish evident would need to be entirely sanded down before oiling.
 - Always oil in the morning, and leave setting to dry, under cover, and with good ventilation.
 - To restore weathered timbers that have lost their original colour consider using **GARDEN FURNITURE OIL- Red Hardwood Enhancer**
- APPEARANCE:** A matt, finish accentuating the natural colours & character of the timber.
- STAINING:** This product is a penetrative, finish and should NOT have other brands of pigment/colourants added or used under it.
- SIZES AVAILABLE:** **All in 500ml, 1 ltr, 2 ltr (10 ltr Clear only)** . For availability visit website home page.

- PREPARATION:**
- Refer again to the **Special Notes** above.
 - Ensure timber surfaces are clean (washed) and dry. (Refer Timber Preparation Sheet)
 - If surfaces are rough/furry, sand off excess fibre with **120-180** grit sandpaper then dust off prior to oiling.
- APPLICATION:**
- Ensure you have read & understood aforementioned **usage, notes** and **preparation** advice first. **If skin-sensitive wear oil-impervious gloves**. Ensure good ventilation.
 - Shake/stir well prior and during use – this maintains an even distribution of ingredients throughout.
 - Using a brush or applicator apply **2** (two) coats a minimum of **24** hours apart (**1** coat only when rejuvenating) **always** dry brush or cloth in excess surface oil within **1** (one) hour of **each** application. If seeking patina/sheen refer Wet Sanding procedure.
- CLEAN UP:** Hot, soapy water or Gum Turpentine.
- MAINTENANCE:**
- Clean (wash) before oiling: Wet timber surfaces with water first, then scrub with an Alkaline salt cleaner i.e. Organoil Wash-A-Way, rinse thoroughly, then allow to dry for a minimum of **48** hours prior to oiling. If timber beads water when rinsing, allow to dry then sand prior to oiling.
 - If timber surfaces are rough/furry after cleaning (washing & drying), sand off excess fibres with **120-180** grit sand paper before oiling.
 - A one coat application (clothed in) every **3 - 12** months depending on the situation/ exposure
- BOTTOM LINE:** Please refer to can's instruction label for other storage, disposal, health and safety considerations.
